



Verver Export has developed a promotional pack specially for municipalities, parks and associations that want to boost biodiversity. Each pack contains 25 bulbs that will increase plant diversity during the summer months and attract various pollinators. # Mix & Match!



You can plant bulb mixtures anywhere: in the middle of the city, at the entrance to a residential estate, on a roundabout or in the park!

The mono mixtures - i.e. a mixture that consists of a single bulb type - keep it simple but effective. In France bulb mixes are often combined with a planting of biennials such as Viola, Bellis, Hesperis and much more. Other clients opt for the stars of the range so that the beds are packed with a wide variety of bulb flowers with a long blooming period.



## Mobile bulb gardens

11000	Classic Botanical Crocus mixture <b>Verver 'Limmen'</b> ©	This mix flowers earlier than the <i>Crocus grandiflora</i> . Sometimes it flowers when snow is on the ground. Take particular notice of the height, it remains modestly sized at just 5 cm.		
11001	Botanical Crocus mixture <b>Verver 'Nature'</b> ©	A very interesting invention! A mix of very hardy crocuses, ideal for naturalising. Plant them in mass in your lawns. Very early-flowering.		
11002	Classic <i>Crocus grandiflora</i> mixture <b>Verver 'Heiloo'</b> ©	Take your locals by surprise. Plant in lawns during the autumn and you will have a carpet of flowers come the spring. If you leave your plants to mature for 6 weeks after they have flowered, you will get the same results the following year. Therefore... it's a great investment!		
11228	<i>Crocus grandiflora</i> mixture <b>Verver 'Early Glow'</b> ©	A pretty <i>Crocus</i> mix where we have chosen a combination of yellow and white. An early and, of course, a very long-lasting bloomer.		
11003	<i>Crocus grandiflora</i> mixture <b>Verver 'Océanique'</b> ©	The same concept as with the traditional 'Heiloo' mix, but in blue and white. Extremely beautiful!		
11120	Very early flowering mixture <b>Verver 'Borkum'</b> ©	The 'Borkum' mix is not particularly understated. Quite the opposite in fact. The contrast between the orange and the blue is formidable and will be seen from afar! A major plus point is that we come and do the planting for you!		
11004	Very early flowering mixture <b>Verver 'Texel'</b> ©	An early-flowering mix of crocuses and tulips that flower together. First you will witness the arrival of the crocuses with the tulips joining them after. Although intended for use in lawns, you can also plant them in beds or under trees.

11007	Very early flowering mixture <b>Verver 'Terschelling'</b> ©	Lovely bright colours combined in one mixture. The result is superb. Crocus flowers long because of the cool temperatures in early spring. As an encore, a beautiful red-yellow tulip providing you with ease 2 months of flowers.	
11008	Grape hyacinth mixture <b>Verver 'Cinq Mousquetaires'</b> ©	Why not select this pretty mix that you can plant in tubs, among your tulips or as a border for a bed of tulips or narcissi? The blue contrasts sharply with the other colours.	
11009	Mixture <b>Verver 'Phares Atlantiques'</b> ©	If you are planning to create blue strips using Muscari, then why not use the 'Phares Atlantiques' composition? The yellow and white of the small Narcissus break the monotony of the Muscari. It can also be used in your lawns.	
11147	Very early flowering mixture <b>Verver 'Xanthic Stars'</b> ©	At the start of spring, this marvellous mix of Tulipa kaufmanniana in yellow, orange and red tones will liven up the shaded areas of your town's squares year after year. Suitable for naturalising, possibly between ground cover.

11365	<p>Mixture with hyacinths and tulips</p> <p><b>Verver 'Dark Treasure'</b> ©</p>	<p>A highly specific combination of colours in which dark hyacinth plays a key role. It will sparkle, even in the shade! For the basic plantation, we recommend red daisies.</p>	
11684	<p>Mid season mixture</p> <p><b>Verver 'Easter Joy'</b> ©</p>	<p>Elegant tulips, in various shades, dance above a yellow blanket of Narcissus. The yellow fritillary towers regally above the mass of flowers.</p>	
11122	<p>Mixture with hyacinths and tulips</p> <p><b>Verver 'Londres'</b> ©</p>	<p>A mix of tulips and hyacinths. Experience the hyacinths first with the tulips joining them a little later. 11151	<p>Mixture with hyacinths and tulips</p> <p><b>Verver 'Parfum des Vosges'</b> ©</p>	<p>Three different tulips and three coloured hyacinths make this a very cheerful composition. The deliciously scented hyacinths flower first and are followed by the tulips meaning that you will have beautiful blooms for 4 to 5 weeks.</p>

### Attractive scent

Although insects do not have a nose, they often have a very good sense of smell. They do that with their antennae, which are packed with cells that detect scents. This enables insects to know a lot about their environment. Insects such as bees and butterflies are important pollinators. They fly from flower to flower and thereby spread pollen. Many flowers such as hyacinths attract pollinators with their distinctive fragrance. So when you plant mixtures with hyacinths, you're also doing your bit for the bees!

11216	Mixture with hyacinths, narcissi and tulips <b>Verver 'Ville de Bourges' ©</b>	A subtle yet successful combination where red tulips and hyacinths frolic among yellow narcissi and pink hyacinths.		
11685	Tulip, narcissi and Fritillaria mixture <b>Verver 'Perfect Green Harmony' ©</b>	These fresh spring colours are in perfect harmony with the green environment. A simple but effective combination: suitable with a biennial plant cover such as Erysimum 'Yellow Bird' here or between perennials.		
11014	Narcissi mixture <b>Verver 'Trio Ciclo' ©</b>	You will get to know the complete range of Narcissus cyclamineus. They are not too tall, have prolific flowers and, above all, are very pretty! We have put them all together in a little mix. I would say that it is particularly well-suited to window boxes.		
11015	Narcissi mixture <b>Verver 'Scala' ©</b>	An interesting mix of all sorts of Narcissus. A flower spectacular.		
11580	Mixture with narcissi and tulips <b>Verver 'Orange Touch' ©</b>	This mixture has two flowering seasons with tulips. In both seasons the color orange is remarkable present. Good to combine with a bi-annual planting in blue, purple and pink.		
11018	Narcissi mixture <b>Verver 'Couronnes Magiques' ©</b>	A mix that enables you to show the public that an interesting diversity can be found among decasplit type narcissi. You will find yourself among pretty colours and shapes. Highly recommended!		
11581	Mixture with hyacinths and narcissi <b>Verver 'Blue Frost' ©</b>	A fantastic mixture with 4 different hyacinths and 4 narcissi. Colour scheme white, yellow and blue, but in very different shades.		
11017	Narcissi mixture <b>Verver 'Double Fountain' ©</b>	This composition of double narcissi offers a springtime mix with much allure. Huge flowers, generously adorned with petals in an interesting pallet of colours. Extremely beautiful!

11124	Mixture with multi flowering varieties <b>Verver 'Victory' ©</b>	These are the shades that I especially like. Bright red, bright orange and salmon. Short, early-flowering and lots of little flowers. Why not plant them in all of your town's window boxes?	
11608	Mid season mixture <b>Verver 'Passion' ©</b>	Surprising combinations of huge hyacinth flowers and the delicate but rich flowering Tulipa turkestanica.

11686	Tulip mixture <b>Verver 'Simple Treat' ©</b>	As the name says: a simple treat. This time for the eyes. A daring colour combination on paper that is really beautiful in reality!	
11027	Early flowering mixture <b>Verver 'Ville d'Auxerre' ©</b>	At the start of spring you will have a collection of tulips in three shades: orange, yellow and white. With their large heads they make their presence known. I recommend that you plant them against a purple or blue background. However, you can also plant them tone on tone.	
11028	Early flowering mixture <b>Verver 'Provençale' ©</b>	As early-flowering as the 'Auxerre', it flowers at the start of the season. The yellow and white colours of the four varieties chosen are always perfectly mixed. Combine this bulb mixture with a plant cover of pink and purple violets or even with an accent of rose-red Bellis.</p>		
11583	<p>Tulip mixture <b>Verver 'Flaming Premnitz'</b> ©</p>	<p>Five very beautiful tulips combined in one mixture? Too much competition or do they lose their individual beauty? No. On the contrary: there's no better way!</p>		
11154	<p>Early flowering mixture <b>Verver 'Ville de Riom'</b> ©</p>	<p>Shimmering orange shades go perfectly with pale yellow as the 'Ville de Riom' shows. A crowned mix of laurels that has been very popular for a number of years now. The key to its success is its big flowers in a combination of wonderful colours.</p>

11218	<p>Mixture with tulips and narcissi <b>Verver 'Ville d'Orchies'</b> ©</p>	<p>Rich mixture! This mixture contains double daffodils and double tulips. It is specially composed for the city of Orchies (FR).</p>

11702	Mixture with tulips and narcissi <b>Verver 'Géraldine'</b> ©	A number of star performers amongst the tulips brought together in one mixture with Narcissus 'Geranium' as a white accent. An example of how different flower shapes combine together beautifully.		
11589	Mixture with hyacinths, narcissi and tulips <b>Verver 'Shooting Stars'</b> ©	Hyacinthus 'Woodstock' is one of the first in this mixture to show colour. Soon after everything revolves around tulip 'Neper'. A colourful combination that also works well with an underplanting of Bellis or Myosotis...		
11037	Tulip mixture <b>Verver 'Sorbet de Fruits Rouges'</b> ©	It was while eating a red fruit sorbet that the idea for this mix came to me! An ensemble of colours worthy of its name. All of the varieties are the same height and flower at the same time. Not forgetting its fine appearance of course.		
11264	Tulip mixture <b>Verver 'Spectacle de Couleurs'</b> ©	Make your spring time bed into a real spectacle with this mix. Not only a combination of several colours, but also of several shapes of flowers. Multicoloured, but harmonious nonetheless!		
11506	Mid season mixture <b>Verver 'Orange Oracle'</b> ©	A combination with Iris bucharica, tulips, Narcissus and Fritillaria. With the sun it looks like your planting gives light. The combination of yellow Viola reinforces this effect.		
11594	Mixture with long flowering time <b>Verver 'Blühendes Heddesheim'</b> ©	A mixture of small grape hyacinths and long-stemmed tulip 'Ballerina'. With nice details by adding hyacinth and Leucojum. Can also be planted mechanically under grass.



# Shower of gold medals for Verver Export





**Almost 1 million bulbs from Verver Export were on display at BUGA (Bundesgartenschau) in Heilbronn (Germany) in spring 2019. During the 'Olympic Games for Gardeners' Verver Export won more than 20 gold medals for its wide range of tulips, daffodils and many other bulb crops.**

The Summer Island and the Rose Garden were a unique sea of flowers, and the flowering strips on the hills that were mechanically planted by Verver Export were a real eyecatcher and a popular photo opportunity. Tijmen Verver also supported the gardening show in the community: sponsored bulbs were used by the residents of Heilbronn in the intercultural garden and by the European mini-gardeners.



One special award was the Grand Gold Medal from the Deutschen-Bundesgartenschau-Gesellschaft (DBG) for a "high quality and varied range of bulbs" and the top prize from the Ministry of the Environment, Agriculture, Nature and Consumer Protection of North Rhine-Westphalia for a "broad, varied, insect-friendly range of bulbs". This fits with the new 'Naturally Special' wilderness catalogue, which also contains mixtures that have a particularly long flowering period and together with flower seeds provide a source food for insects throughout the year.



11584	Mixture with tulips, hyacinths and Muscari <b>Verver 'Spring Fair'</b> ©	A lovely colourful tulip mixture topped with Muscari and a hyacinth. Colourful but surprising.		
11349	Mid season mixture <b>Verver 'So Special'</b> ©	Soft pastel tones that make it very special. A wide variety of flower shapes that attract plenty of attention. Base planting of Hesperis and yellow pansies would complete this mix perfectly!		
11156	Mid season mixture <b>Verver 'Ville de Toulon'</b> ©	A powerful mix with many very cheerful shades of yellow accentuated with orange. A huge impact thanks to the colour combinations and the structure: created in levels with dwarf and tall tulips, small and large narcissi and the extremely imposing Fritillaria imperialis.		
11631	Mid season mixture <b>Verver 'Ville de Belfort'</b> ©	Lovely warm shades with a striking contrast between the fragile flowers of Narcissus 'Baby Boomer' and the big flowers of the crown imperial.		
11265	Tulip and narcissi mixture <b>Verver 'Harmony'</b> ©	A huge variety of flower shapes comprising mainly of botanical tulips and narcissi. Plant densely and your results will be dazzling!		
11039	Tulip mixture <b>Verver 'Ville de Malakoff'</b> ©	A spectacular mix. The background of yellow tulips emphasises the orange of the simple tulip. Then there is a little bit of purple to contrast with the other shades. The heights vary. This mix is hardly understated and attracts attention!		
11587	Tulip, narcissi and Muscari mixture <b>Verver 'Cheappuccino'</b> ©	A mixture of real classics from the flower bulb world. Many yellow with a pinkish-red accent from Tulipa 'Jimmy' and the blue of forget-me-nots. Suitable for multi-year flowering.



11611	Tulip mixture <b>Verver 'Soft Dreams' ©</b>	A flower bed full of pearls after planting this mixture. Full, big flowers empowered by the combination of apricot and lilac colours.	
11505	Mixture with long flowering time <b>Verver 'Hello Yellow and Blue' ©</b>	The demand for harder colour combinations rises. Therefore we introduce this new yellow-blue combination. Perhaps coincidentally your city colors?	
11047	Mixture with double Murillo-tulips <b>Verver 'Premix Murillo' ©</b>	The most well-known of all the mixes. And a real asset to us here at Verver Export. There is no need for worry if this mix has been properly prepared. This mix has been particularly well-conceived by our house: more than 12 double varieties are included.	
11585	Tulip mixture <b>Verver 'Purple Haze' ©</b>	Seven different tulips: not only in colour but also in form. The purple colour hangs the entire flowering period as a mist through the planting. If you want to strengthen it, there are many kinds of Viola available in this color scheme.

## Chameleon

The 'Cartouche' tulip plays an important role in the Verver 'Touche Douceur' mixture. This double late tulip is the product of a cross between T. 'Amethyst' (mother) and T. 'Monte Carlo' (father). It was officially registered in 2007 by Vertuco, an important tulip breeding group in the Netherlands. The nice thing about 'Cartouche' is that it's a bit of a chameleon. It starts strongly white with a red edge, whereby the red edge increasingly lightens towards pink as the flower ripens.



## Feminine

Colours play a major role in the feeling that something gives us. Colour associations are created by culture, fashion, experience, personal preference and perception, amongst other things. Human memory is prompted by visual stimuli, and colour is one of them. The combination of purple, pink and white is commonly considered a feminine combination, and is used a lot by landscape designers. The harmonious effect is achieved by remaining within one colour family and using it in various shades. White is a neutral colour that plays the 'lightening' role in this colour combination.

- 3 Start planning early and reserve your bulbs immediately!
